Ideas for using the alphabet stampers

- Random letter chosen for vocab challenge/sentence starters
- Random letters displayed everywhere. Students challenged to make longest word with the letters.
- In groups, make up as many words possible when given only certain letters.
- Randomly stamp an initial into an exercise book during the lesson. The owner of the exercise book has to ask a question to someone whose name begins with that initial.
- In groups, one person stamps a letter in a book of another group. Each group has to come up with a sentence/phrase that starts with that letter. Repeat for five stamps to create a story.
- Class in teams. Stampers around the rom. Teacher calls out a word to spell. Students send one team member at a time to fetch one stamper. First team to spell the word, by stamping it on paper, wins.
