

Ideas for using the squeaky chicken toy

- With Year 12, students have to make an advert to sell this product. They can then use it as a prop in their adverts!
- Play “Taboo”. Put students into two teams. They have to create a sentence in the TL avoiding “boring” adjectives (provide them with a list). They take turns. The opposing team has the chicken and listens carefully, squeaking it if they use any of the listed words.
- Use in “Just a Minute” speaking activity. Students squeak the chicken when their partner pauses, makes an error, etc.
- Play a conversation, then stop it at points, asking groups to guess the next word. The group that gets it right gets to squeak the chicken!
- Use as a timer. Students must talk on a topic until the teacher squeaks the chicken.
- Use the chicken as a reward: students can squeeze the chicken after a correct answer.
