

## Ideas for using the tablecloths

- Use for a “most developed graffiti” competition
- Draw bricks on it and fill in key vocab for a topic wall
- Mind map on topic/character in groups. Display/reuse to support classwork.
- Use as a “Tense Tablecloth”. Student “experts” write rules on it with their knowledge. Other learners move from table to table to learn.
- Use in group work: groups write on it before presenting to the class
- Turn each tablecloth into a poncho. Label each one with a theme/character. Students have to write ideas/comments on the back.
- Use to design banners for/against a contentious issue. Students use post it notes or pens to “deface” with comments in response.
- Get students to write different sentences in different tenses about different topics and bring together as a story.
- For revision: vocab tablecloths. Different topic for vocabulary on each table.
